IMMIGRATION RIGHTS ALERT NO.3

TOPIC: FEDERAL JUDGE STOPS PRESIDENT OBAMA'S IMPLEMENTATION OF DACA WHICH WAS SCHEDULED TO COMMENCE ON THURSDAY, FEBRUARY 18, 2015:

DATE: February 9, 2015

This is the THIRD of numerous alerts and updates concerning this important issue:

On Monday, February 16, 2015, U.S. District Court Judge, Andrew Hansen in Brownsville, Texas, issued a Preliminary Injunction against the Obama Administration ("DHS-USCIS") from implementing the scheduled acceptance of initial/renewal of DACA relief. This is a result of a lawsuit that was recently filed against the Obama Administration by the State of Texas and numerous other States.

According to an administration press release issued a few hours ago, "DHS will not begin accepting requests for the expansion of DACA tomorrow, February 18, as originally planned. Until further notice, we will also suspend the plan to accept requests for DAPA" (see Alert # 1).

The Obama Administration plans to file an Appeal of Judge Hansen's decision to a higher court and it is believed that a decision will be rendered within the next five (5) days or so. The Administration believes that the Appellate Court will overturn Judge Hansen's decision.

In the meantime, if you are planning on filing for DACA relief, take this time to download the applications and obtain the documents and proof that must be attached to the application as well as the non-refundable filing fee.

We will keep you posted of further developments on this important issue.
